1 Title

 - (a) delete “within Three Year Quota Blocks”; and
 - (b) after “meeting”, insert “, as amended at CCSBT 21 in 2014”.
- (5) In the Schedule, paragraph (p), after “2013”, insert “, as amended at CCSBT 21 in 2014”.
