1 Title

This order is the Education (Specified Institutions) Order 2015.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 July 2015.

3 Interpretation

In this order, **Act** means the Education Act 1989.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 2015, amends the list of special institutions in Schedule 5 of the Education Act 1989 (the **Act**).

A special institution listed in Schedule 5 of the Act must have the composition of its board of trustees determined by the Minister of Education.

The effect of the amendments is to—

 - Northern Hospitals School is now called Northern Health School:
