### **Proposal for transfer of assets and liabilities from Health Benefits Limited to NZ Health Partnerships Limited**

## Order

### 1 Title

This order is the Health Sector Transfers (NZ Health Partnerships Limited) Order 2015.

### 2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 July 2015.

### 3 Approval of proposal

The proposal set out in the Schedule is approved.

### 4 Date on which proposal takes effect

The proposal set out in the Schedule takes effect on 1 July 2015.

### 5 Provisions facilitating transfer of assets and liabilities

(1) It is declared that on and from 1 July 2015—

- (a) a reference to the transferor in any regulations, order, notice, or document is deemed to be a reference to the transferee; and
- (b) the transferee assumes the rights and obligations of the transferor in respect of applications for rights, objections, or proceedings before any court, authority, or other person; and
- (c) this order is deemed to be notice to all persons, and specific notice need not be given to any authority or other person.

(2) The Registrar of Companies is directed to register or record the declaration.

### 6 Earlier order revoked

The Health Reforms (Transfer of Assets and Liabilities of Health Benefits Limited) Order 2000 (SR 2000/279) is revoked.

## Schedule

### Proposal for transfer of assets and liabilities from Health Benefits Limited to NZ Health Partnerships Limited

### 1 Background

This proposal has been prepared in accordance with section 5 of the Health Sector (Transfers) Act 1993 for the purpose of transferring all the assets and liabilities of Health Benefits Limited to NZ Health Partnerships Limited.

### 2 Transferor

The transferor is Health Benefits Limited.

**3 Transferee**

The transferee is NZ Health Partnerships Limited.

**4 Description of assets to be transferred**

The assets to be transferred to the transferee are all the assets for the time being of the transferor.

**5 Description of liabilities to be transferred**

The liabilities to be transferred to the transferee are all the liabilities for the time being of the transferor.

**6 Values attributed to assets and liabilities for the purpose of transfer**

- (1) The value attributed to the assets to be transferred is \$610,381,000.
- (2) The value attributed to the liabilities to be transferred is \$600,224,000.

**7 Transfer of assets without consideration**

The transferor is to transfer the assets referred to in clause 4 without receiving any asset in return.

**8 Transfer date**

The transfer date is 1 July 2015.

**9 Date and execution**

This proposal is dated 11 June 2015 and is signed by the transferring Ministers, Simon William English, Minister of Finance, and Jonathan David Coleman, Minister of Health.
