Pursuant to section RA 21(3) and (4) of the Income Tax Act 2007, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

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Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Income Tax (Fringe Benefit Tax, Interest on Loans) Amendment Regulations 2015.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Income Tax (Fringe Benefit Tax, Interest on Loans) Regulations 1995 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Schedule 1 amended

In Schedule 1, after the item relating to the quarter commencing 1 October 2014, insert:

Quarter commencing 1 July 2015, and subsequent quarters	6.22

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Income Tax (Fringe Benefit Tax, Interest on Loans) Regulations 1995.

These regulations reduce, from 6.70% to 6.22%, the rate of interest that applies for fringe benefit tax purposes to employment-related loans. The reduction applies for the quarter beginning on 1 July 2015 and for subsequent quarters.
