Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991 Amendment Regulations 2016.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2016.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Regulation 20 amended (International passenger security charges)

- (1) In regulation 20(1), replace “2017” with “2016” in each place.
- (2) In regulation 20(1), replace “\$11.01” with “\$10.58”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2016, amend regulation 20(1) of the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991 (the **principal regulations**). The amendments amend a critical date in regulation 20(1) and decrease the fee payable on or after that new date having the cumulative effect as follows:

- on or after 1 April 2014, but before 1 April 2016, an international operator must pay to the Civil Aviation Authority \$11.98 for each passenger on a flight departing from New Zealand (other than the passengers listed in regulation 20(2)) for the purpose of funding the Aviation Security Service; and
- on or after 1 April 2016, an international operator must pay to the Civil Aviation Authority \$10.58 for each passenger on a flight departing from New Zealand (other than the passengers listed in regulation 20(2)) for the purpose of funding the Aviation Security Service.

The amounts are inclusive of GST (*see* regulation 33 of the principal regulations).
