Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf (Environmental Effects—Discharge and Dumping) Amendment Regulations 2017.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 December 2017.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf (Environmental Effects—Discharge and Dumping) Regulations 2015 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Regulation 4 amended (Meaning of harmful substance)

In regulation 4, replace “Hazardous Substances (Minimum Degrees of Hazard) Regulations 2001” with “Hazardous Substances (Minimum Degrees of Hazard) Notice 2017”.

5 Regulation 24 amended (ESRP for spills of harmful substances described in regulation 4(a))

In regulation 24(3)(a), replace “table in Schedule 6 of the Hazardous Substances (Classification) Regulations 2001” with “Hazardous Substances (Classification) Notice 2017”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 December 2017, amend the Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf (Environmental Effects—Discharge and Dumping) Regulations 2015. The amendments replace references to certain regulations made under the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 with references to notices that replace those regulations.
