## Order

### 1 Title

This order is the Fire and Emergency New Zealand Act Commencement Order Revocation Order 2018.

### 2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 3 May 2018.

### 3 Revocation

The Fire and Emergency New Zealand Act Commencement Order 2017 (LI 2017/103) is revoked.

### 4 Revocation of this order

This order is revoked on 31 May 2018.

## Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 3 May 2018, revokes the Fire and Emergency New Zealand Act Commencement Order 2017 (the **principal order**).

The principal order was made with the intention of bringing the levy-related provisions in sections 80 to 140 of the Fire and Emergency New Zealand Act 2017 (the **Act**) into force on 1 January 2019. However, since the making of the principal order, it has become clear that there would not be sufficient time to implement all necessary changes in levy arrangements before 1 January 2019.

The effect of this order is that the principal order is revoked and, in accordance with section 2(6) of the Act, sections 80 to 140 of the Act will come into force on 1 July 2019. Accordingly, the current transitional levy arrangements under the Fire and Emergency New Zealand (Levy Rates and Information Requirements in Transitional Period) Regulations 2017 will continue to be in force until the close of 30 June 2019.

This order is revoked on 31 May 2018.
