1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (High Seas Fishing Notifications—Commission for the Conservation of Southern Bluefin Tuna) Amendment Notice 2019.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Principal notice

This notice amends the Fisheries (High Seas Fishing Notifications—Commission for the Conservation of Southern Bluefin Tuna) Notice 2009 (the **principal notice**).
