### Notice

#### 1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Area/Rohe Moana of Te Rūnanga o Arowhenua) Notice 2019.

#### 2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

#### 3 Revocation of this notice

This notice is revoked at the end of 10 December 2023.

#### 4 Customary food gathering area/rohe moana

This notice applies to the customary food gathering area/rohe moana defined by clause 2(c) of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Notice (No. 2) 1998 (*Gazette* 1998, p 3587), which is an area from the Pareora River to Whakatu (north of the Ashburton River/Hakaterere).

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette* and revokes itself at the end of 10 December 2023.

The notice relates to a customary food gathering area/rohe moana of the tangata whenua represented by Te Rūnanga o Arowhenua. The area/rohe moana is an area from the Pareora River to Whakatu (north of the Ashburton River/Hakaterere).
