Notice

1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Area/Rohe Moana of Kāti Huirapa Rūnaka ki Puketeraki) Notice 2019.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Revocation of this notice

This notice is revoked at the end of 23 October 2023.

4 Customary food gathering area/rohe moana

This notice applies to the customary food gathering area/rohe moana defined by clause 2(c) of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Notice (No. 9) 1999 (*Gazette* 1999, p 562), which is to an area from Waihemo to Purehurehure, in North Otago.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette* and revokes itself at the end of 23 October 2023.

The notice relates to a customary food gathering area/rohe moana of the tangata whenua represented by Kāti Huirapa Rūnaka ki Puketeraki. The area/rohe moana is an area from Waihemo to Purehurehure, in North Otago.

Notice is given of the reappointment of 6 Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the area/rohe moana. The Minister of Fisheries made the reappointments at the request of Kāti Huirapa Rūnaka ki Puketeraki.

The powers of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki are set out in the regulations.
