Notice

1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Area/Rohe Moana of Te Rūnaka o Makaawhio) Notice (No 2) 2019.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 15 August 2019.

3 Revocation of this notice

This notice is revoked at the end of 16 December 2023.

4 Customary food gathering area/rohe moana

This notice applies to the customary food gathering area/rohe moana defined by clause 3(b) of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Notice (No. 2) 2007 (*Gazette* 2007, p 2258), which is an area from the Pouerua River to the Hokitika River on the west coast of the South Island.

5 Appointment cancelled

- (1) The Minister of Fisheries has cancelled the appointment of Richard Rangi Wallace as a Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the area/rohe moana.
- (2) The cancellation took effect at the end of 16 December 2018.

6 New appointment

- (1) The Minister of Fisheries has appointed William Wilson as a Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the area/rohe moana.
- (2) The appointment—
 - (a) took effect on 17 December 2018; and
 - (b) expires at the end of 16 December 2023.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on 15 August 2019 and revokes itself at the end of 16 December 2023.

The notice relates to a customary food gathering area/rohe moana of the tangata whenua represented by Te Rūnaka o Makaawhio. The area/rohe moana is an area from the Pouerua River to the Hokitika River on the west coast of the South Island.

Notice is given of the cancellation of the appointment of a Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the area/rohe moana and the appointment of a replacement. The Minister of Fisheries made the cancellation and appointment at the request of Te Rūnaka o Makaawhio.

The powers of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki are set out in the regulations.
