1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Waitarakao Mātaitai Reserve) Notice 2019.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 31 January 2020.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on 31 January 2020 and revokes itself at the end of 20 August 2024.

The notice relates to the Waitarakao Mātaitai Reserve, which is in the Washdyke Lagoon area of South Canterbury. The tangata whenua of the area that includes the mātaitai reserve are represented by Te Rūnanga o Arowhenua.

The notice relates to—

- the appointment of 2 Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the mātaitai reserve; and
- the reappointment of 12 Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the mātaitai reserve.

The Minister of Fisheries made the appointments and reappointments at the request of Te Rūnanga o Arowhenua.

The powers of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki are set out in the regulations.
