Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 26 April 2021, sections 92 to 94 of the Ngāti Tūwharetoa Claims Settlement Act 2018 (the **Act**). These sections relate to the Ōnekeneke Recreation Reserve, which is a cultural redress property under the Act (*see* section 90 of the Act and the description of the Ōnekeneke property in Schedule 3 of the Act).
