#### **1 Title**

This order is the Ombudsmen (Health New Zealand and Māori Health Authority) Order 2021.

#### **2 Commencement**

This order comes into force on 1 September 2021.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 1 September 2021, inserts the names of Health New Zealand and the Māori Health Authority into Part 1A of Schedule 1 of the Ombudsmen Act 1975. Health New Zealand and the Māori Health Authority are new departmental agencies to which the Public Service Act 2020 applies (*see* the Public Service (Health New Zealand and Māori Health Authority) Order 2021).

The effect of this order is that both the Ombudsmen Act 1975 and the Official Information Act 1982 apply to Health New Zealand and the Māori Health Authority.
