## Regulations

### 1 Title

These regulations are the Motor Vehicle Sales (Motor Vehicle Disputes Tribunals Funding Levy) Amendment Regulations 2022.

## 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 August 2022.

## 3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Motor Vehicle Sales (Motor Vehicle Disputes Tribunals Funding Levy) Regulations 2003.

## 4 Regulation 4 amended (Amount of Motor Vehicle Disputes Tribunals funding levy)

In regulation 4, replace “\$127” with “\$210”.

## 5 Regulation 6 amended (GST included)

- (1) In the heading to regulation 6, replace “**included**” with “**excluded**”.
- (2) In regulation 6, replace “inclusive” with “exclusive”.

## Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the Motor Vehicle Sales (Motor Vehicle Disputes Tribunals Funding Levy) Regulations 2003 and come into force on 1 August 2022. These regulations increase from \$127 (including goods and services tax) to \$210 (excluding goods and services tax) the annual Motor Vehicle Disputes Tribunals levy payable by motor vehicle traders under the Motor Vehicle Sales Act 2003.
