Order

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Companies Special Investigations Order (No 3) 1988.
- (2) This order shall come into force on 7 November 1988.

2 Act to apply to certain companies

It is hereby declared that the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958 shall apply to the companies named in the Schedule.

3 Receivers and managers

Roderick Thomas McKenzie of Palmerston North, Chartered Accountant, and William John Henry Stewart of Napier, Chartered Accountant, are hereby appointed receivers and managers in respect of each company to which this order applies.

Notes

1 *General*
