Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Order 2001

(SR 2001/329)

Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Order 2001: revoked (after expiring on 8 November 2007), on 8 November 2015, by clause 5(b) of the Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Order 2015 (LI 2015/241).

PURSUANT to section 54 of the Customs and Excise Act 1996, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

1 Title

This order is the Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Order 2001.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 8 November 2001.

3 Expiry

This order expires at the close of 7 November 2007.

This order is administered by the New Zealand Customs Service.

Clause 3 was amended, as from 7 November 2004, by clause 3 Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Amendment Order 2004 (SR 2004/368) by substituting the expression “7 November 2007” for the expression “7 November 2004”.

4 Interpretation

- (1) In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, **trout products** means any part of a trout; and includes the excrement, secretion, semen, or egg of a trout.
- (2) Terms used and not defined in this order but defined in the Customs and Excise Act 1996 have the meaning given to them by that Act.

5 Importation of trout and trout products prohibited

The importation of the goods specified in the Schedule, in quantities of 10 or more kilograms, or in quantities of less than 10 kilograms if the goods are intended for sale, is prohibited, except with the consent of, and subject to such conditions (if any) not inconsistent with this prohibition as may be imposed by the Minister of Conservation.

The following species of trout, alive or dead:

- (a) brown trout (*Salmo trutta*):
- (b) rainbow trout (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*, formerly known as *Salmo gairdneri*):
- (c) American brook trout or char (*Salvelinus fontinalis*):
- (d) lake trout or char (*Salvelinus namaycush*):
- (e) cutthroat trout (*Oncorhynchus clarki*, formerly known as *Salmo clarki*):
- (f) golden trout (*Oncorhynchus aguabonita*, formerly known as *Salmo aguabonita*):
- (g) gila trout (*Oncorhynchus gilae*, formerly known as *Salmo gilae*):
- (h) apache trout (*Oncorhynchus apache*):
- (i) Mexican trout (*Oncorhynchus chrysogaster*):
- (j) any hybrid of a trout listed in paragraphs (a) to (i).

Any trout product that is derived from a trout listed in item 1.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 8 November 2001, prohibits the importation of trout and trout products in quantities of 10 or more kilograms, or less than 10 kilograms if the goods are intended for sale, except with the consent of and subject to such conditions as may be imposed by the Minister of Conservation. The order expires at the close of 7 November 2004.
