Biosecurity (Bovine Tuberculosis—Cattle Levy) Amendment Order 2004: revoked, on 1 August 2016, pursuant to clause 27 of the Biosecurity (Bovine Tuberculosis—Cattle and Deer Levy) Order 2016 (LI 2016/111).

Pursuant to section 90 of the Biosecurity Act 1993, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

**1 Title**

- (1) This order is the Biosecurity (Bovine Tuberculosis—Cattle Levy) Amendment Order 2004.
- (2) In this order, the Biosecurity (Bovine Tuberculosis—Cattle Levy) Order 1998<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal order”.

**2 Commencement**

This order comes into force on 2 September 2004.

### 3 Interpretation

Clause 2(1) of the principal order is amended by revoking the definition of **adult cattle**, and substituting the following definition:

**adult cattle** means a cattle beast that is or exceeds 40 kg dressed weight

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 2 September 2004, amends the definition of **adult cattle** in the Biosecurity (Bovine Tuberculosis—Cattle Levy) Order 1998 (the 1998 Order).

A cattle beast must weigh or exceed 40 kg dressed weight, rather than exceed 27 kg dressed weight under the 1998 Order, to come within the definition of adult cattle.
