Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 27 July 2017, the remaining provisions of the Geographical Indications (Wine and Spirits) Registration Act 2006 (the **Act**) that have not earlier been brought into force.

Section 62 of the Act, which repealed the Geographical Indications Act 1994, was brought into force on 14 April 2008 by clause 2 of the Geographical Indications Act 1994 Repeal Order 2008 (SR 2008/64).
