### **Order**

**1 Title**

This order is the Biosecurity (Notifiable Organisms) Amendment Order 2018.

**2 Commencement**

This order comes into force on 10 September 2018.

**3 Principal order**

This order amends the Biosecurity (Notifiable Organisms) Order 2016 (the **principal order**).

**4 Schedule amended**

In the Schedule, item relating to organisms primarily affecting cattle, insert in its appropriate alphabetical order:

*Mycoplasma bovis*

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 10 September 2018, amends the Biosecurity (Notifiable Organisms) Order 2016.

It adds *Mycoplasma bovis* to the list of notifiable organisms in the Schedule as an organism primarily affecting cattle. The effect of this amendment is that the duty to report the presence or possible presence of notifiable organisms under section 46 of the Biosecurity Act 1993 applies to *Mycoplasma bovis*.
