## Regulations

### 1 Title

These regulations are the Veterans' Support Amendment Regulations (No 6) 2021.

### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 20 January 2022.

### 3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Veterans' Support Regulations 2014.

### 4 Schedule 1 amended

Amend Schedule 1 as set out in Schedule 1 of these regulations.

### 5 Schedule 2A amended

Amend Schedule 2A as set out in Schedule 2 of these regulations.

## Schedule 1 Schedule 1 amended

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In the item relating to carpal tunnel syndrome,—

- (a) replace “7/2013” with “93/2021”; and
- (b) replace “8/2013” with “94/2021”.

In the item relating to chronic fatigue syndrome,—

- (a) replace “11/2014” with “105/2021”; and
- (b) replace “12/2014” with “106/2021”.

In the item relating to chronic gastritis and chronic gastropathy,—

- (a) replace “25/2013” with “101/2021”; and
- (b) replace “26/2013” with “102/2021”.

Replace the item relating to dental pulp and apical disease with:

dental pulp and periapical disease	99/2021	100/2021
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In the item relating to essential thrombocythaemia,—

- (a) replace “15/2013” with “91/2021”; and
- (b) replace “16/2013” with “92/2021”.

In the item relating to familial adenomatous polyposis,—

- (a) replace “39/2013” with “77/2021”; and
- (b) replace “40/2013” with “78/2021”.

In the item relating to fibromyalgia,—

- (a) replace “13/2014” with “107/2021”; and
- (b) replace “14/2014” with “108/2021”.

In the item relating to fibrosing interstitial lung disease,—

- (a) replace “53/2013” with “85/2021”; and
- (b) replace “54/2013” with “86/2021”.

In the item relating to malignant neoplasm of the pancreas,—

- (a) replace “73/2013” with “103/2021”; and
- (b) replace “74/2013” with “104/2021”.

In the item relating to myeloma,—

- (a) replace “69/2012” with “95/2021”; and
- (b) replace “70/2012” with “96/2021”.

In the item relating to polycythaemia vera,—

- (a) replace “11/2013” with “87/2021”; and
- (b) replace “12/2013” with “88/2021”.

In the item relating to primary myelofibrosis,—

- (a) replace “17/2013” with “89/2021”; and
- (b) replace “18/2013” with “90/2021”.

In the item relating to solar keratosis,—

- (a) replace “73/2012” with “79/2021”; and
- (b) replace “74/2012” with “80/2021”.

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 20 January 2022, amend the Veterans' Support Regulations 2014 (the **principal regulations**).

*Regulation 4 and Schedule 1* amend Schedule 1 of the principal regulations, which lists the Australian statements of principles (the **statements**) that apply to specified medical conditions for the purposes of the Veterans' Support Act 2014 (the **Act**). The amendments—

- replace the name of the condition dental pulp and apical disease in order to reflect the statements (the new name is dental pulp and periapical disease);
- update references to the statements.

*Regulation 5 and Schedule 2* amend Schedule 2A of the principal regulations, which lists accepted late-onset conditions for the purposes of the definition of accepted late-onset condition in section 7 of the Act. The amendment inserts 4 new accepted late-onset conditions (hypogonadism, mesenteric panniculitis, pure red cell aplasia, and transverse myelitis).
