**1 Title**

This order is the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Act 2023 Commencement Order 2023.

**2 Commencement of certain provisions of Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Act 2023**

The following provisions of the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Act 2023 come into force on 13 July 2023:

- (a) section 10 to the extent that it relates to new section 10(4) of the Freedom Camping Act 2011:
- (b) section 14(3), which relates to new section 15(2) of that Act:
- (c) section 17 to the extent that it relates to new section 19A(2) of that Act:
- (d) section 18 to the extent that it relates to new sections 20(1)(c), 20A(b), and 20B(c) of that Act.

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 13 July 2023, certain sections of the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Act 2023. Those sections insert new sections into the Freedom Camping Act 2011 (the **2011 Act**). New sections 10(4), 15(2), and 19A(2) of the 2011 Act require a person freedom camping in a motor vehicle in certain areas to display a warrant card in the vehicle. New sections 20(1)(c), 20A(b), and 20B(c) of the 2011 Act are the associated offence provisions.
