1 Title

This notice is the Education (Domestic Student: Primary and Secondary Education) Amendment Notice 2026.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 25 March 2026.

3 Principal notice

This notice amends the Education (Domestic Student: Primary and Secondary Education) Notice 2026.

4 Schedule amended

- (1) In the Schedule, item 11, replace “applicable visa” with “applicable student visa”.
- (2) In the Schedule, item 12, replace “A person” with “A person who holds a student visa and”.
- (3) In the Schedule, item 13, delete “who holds a student visa and”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 25 March 2026, amends the Schedule of the Education (Domestic Student: Primary and Secondary Education) Notice 2026, which specifies persons who are required to be treated as if they are not international students in respect of Part 3 and related provisions of the Education and Training Act 2020.

The amendments—

- clarify that the applicable visa referred to in item 11 of the Schedule is the applicable student visa; and
- make corrections to items 12 and 13 of the Schedule where the words “who holds a student visa” are incorrectly transposed.
