Te Ture Whenua Māori Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 3 Bills

Hon Te Ururoa Flavell, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, Parts 1 to 9, and Schedules 1 to 4* be a separate Bill, and that the enacting words and *clauses 1 and 2* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is Te Ture Whenua Māori Act **2017**.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Act comes into force on a date or dates set by Order in Council, and 1 or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates and for different purposes.
- (2) Any provision that is not already in force at the end of the 18-month period that starts on the date of Royal assent comes into force then.
- (3) In this section, **provision** includes any item or part of an item in any of the schedules.

That *Parts 10 to 15 and Schedules 5 to 7* be a separate Bill, and that, above the Part 10 heading, there be inserted:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is Te Kooti Whenua Māori Act **2017**.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Act comes into force on a date or dates set by Order in Council, and 1 or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates and for different purposes.
- (2) Any provision that is not already in force at the end of the 18-month period that starts on the date of Royal assent comes into force then.
- (3) In this section, **provision** includes any item or part of an item in any of the schedules.

That *Part 16* and *Schedules 8 to 12* be a separate Bill, and that the heading to Part 16 be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is Te Ture Whenua Māori (Repeals and Amendments) Act **2017**.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Act comes into force on a date or dates set by Order in Council, and 1 or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates and for different purposes.
- (2) Any provision that is not already in force at the end of the 18-month period that starts on the date of Royal assent comes into force then.
- (3) **Subsections (1) and (2)** apply with the following exceptions:
 - (a) **subpart 3** comes into force on the day after the date of Royal assent:
 - (b) **subpart 4** comes into force on the first 1 July that falls—
 - (i) at least 9 months after the date of Royal assent; and
 - (ii) after the date on which all of Te Ture Whenua Māori Act **2017** has come into force.
- (4) In this section, **provision** includes any item or part of an item in any of the schedules.
