## Education (Update) Amendment Bill

### *Proposed amendments*

Catherine Delahunty, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

#### *Clause 4*

In *clause 4*, *new section 1A(3)(c)(iv)*, replace “and te reo Māori.” (page 14, line 5) with “:”.

In *clause 4*, after *new section 1A(3)(c)(iv)* (page 14, after line 5), insert:

- (v) te reo Māori through the teaching of Te Reo Māori as a core subject in the national curriculum up to Year 10.

### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends *clause 4* in the Education (Update) Amendment Bill to enable the teaching of Te Reo Māori to every New Zealand child up until Year 10. We have a responsibility to ensure that our indigenous language thrives in Aotearoa, and introducing all children to it at school is the best way to make that happen.
