Electoral (Integrity) Amendment Bill

Proposed amendment

Hon Dr Nick Smith, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

New clause 7

After *clause 6* (page 4, after line 18), insert:

7 New section 63(2)(c)(viii) inserted (Application for registration)

After section 63(2)(c)(vii), insert:

(viii) be accompanied by evidence, in a form approved by the Electoral Commission, that the party has rules governing expulsion of members of Parliament under **sections 55AAB to 55E**.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Electoral (Integrity) Amendment Bill to add a *new clause 7* to enhance public confidence in the electoral system by requiring parties to have rules around expulsion of MPs by party leaders if they wish to be registered.
